Education Chair Report

An email blast went out to inform you of the potential classes that could be presented later this year. They were as follows:

Course No. 200: Principles of Real Estate Negotiations

Course No. 901: Principles of Real Estate Engineering

Course No. 506: Advanced Business Relocation

However, since Course No. 200 is offered on line, it is better to offer Course No. 201 which is Communications in Real Estate Acquisition. However, it is a 3 day course versus a 2 day course. I recall 201 being a very good hands on class where we took a video of ourselves to help identify our strengths and weaknesses. This is something we can decide now. (Take a vote)

Secondly, we can also present Course No. 900, which is Principles of Real Estate Engineering. This class is required for the RWP curriculums. Attached is a list of the IRWA courses and the descriptions. I have copies of curriculums too, however, these are specific to the courses that you already have, based on your course history and the recommendations in the Credentialing Concierge. Let me know if you need a copy of the curriculums.

Thirdly, after deliberation, it appears that Course number 213, Conflict Management would be the last best class to present. When including, this class, chapter 37 has presented almost all the classes that are required for RWA designations this year. If you have currently completed the requirements, you owe it to yourself to obtain the designation. The only other requirement is either Course No 102, 103 or 104, and both 103, and 104 are offer on line. They are very easy.

The IRWA credentialing concierge system can assist in making the determination of which certifications you are eligible to obtain. You are still encouraged to investigate your courses history and act accordingly. Please visit the site at your convenience and see where you stand.
